- 2) **Best Scientific Research Project that integrates diversity** (sex, gender, further intersectional variables like age, specific diseases etc.)


For each category up to 3 proposals will be awarded by December 2019 (in total: 6 proposals). The winning proposals will

- have free registration and travel costs for the HBP Summit or another HBP-relevant conference in a similar prize range.
- be given the opportunity to present their achievements to a large audience at the HBP Summit.
- be honoured at the HBP Summit, via the website and further Social Media news channels.

The Call opens on 25 June 2019, and closes on 14 October 2019, 17:00 Brussels time (CET).


